



## Addendum to the RU Adobe Presenter 6.1 Guide:

Modifying an Adobe Presenter Presentation so that Embedded Quizzes are Scored and Reported to a Gradebook Column in WebCT/Blackboard CE 6

### The General Steps are:

1. Create a PowerPoint
  2. Use the Adobe Connect plugin to add narration and quiz questions
  3. Use the Adobe Connect plugin to configure SCORM settings. (This tells the presentation how to report quiz results to Blackboard)
  4. Publish the presentation to a .zip file
  5. Use the Blackboard SCORM importer to upload the .zip file and add the presentation to your Blackboard course. A column is automatically added to the 'SCORM' grade sections of Blackboard.
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### Detailed Steps for Publishing Your Quiz-Enabled Adobe Presenter Presentation to a SCORM Package

1. Go to the Adobe Presenter Menu and select, 'Quiz Manager'.
2. Select, 'Enable reporting for this presentation'
3. Select the 'SCORM' option
  - a. Click the 'Manifest' button
  - b. Select 1.2 as the version
  - c. Under the 'SCO' heading type a grade book column name in the 'Title' field. Note: There is more than one 'Title' field, be sure to use the one under the 'SCO' heading.
  - d. Click 'ok'
4. Select, 'Report to Adobe Connect Enterprise'
5. Select, 'Report status as defined by report data'
6. Under the heading, 'Report score to LMS' select 'Score'
7. Under the heading, 'Reporting Level' select 'Only report the score'
  - a. Click the 'Settings' button (under the heading 'Advanced')

- b. Make sure that only the "Escape Version and Session ID" box is checked and click 'ok'.
8. Click 'OK' again.
9. Return to the 'Adobe Presenter' menu and select 'Publish'.
10. Browse to a save location on 'My Computer' (Desktop is usually a good location)
11. Select the 'Zip files' box under the heading 'Output Options'
12. Click Publish

## **Import the SCORM enabled presentation to Blackboard**

1. Login to your course
2. Click the 'build' tab
3. Select 'SCORM' in the course tools menu. ---Note: If SCORM is not listed you can go to the Designer Tools menu and select 'Manage Course'...'Tools'...'SCORM'
4. Click 'Create SCORM Module' and fill in the requested information.
  - a. The title will be the link title in the Blackboard course
  - b. Select 'Gradable'
  - c. Select 'Do not display navigation controls'
  - d. Browse to the .zip file (that you saved earlier)
  - e. Click 'Save'
5. You can check the box next to any imported SCORM module and then use the 'Create Link on:' drop down menu to place a link to the SCORM module anywhere in your course.

**Note:** *The grades for SCORM modules will appear in the gradebook section titled, 'SCORM grades'.*
